

Leaf Pick Up

The Village collects loose leaves at the roads edge twice per year, during the months of October and November in the fall and April and May in the spring. To ensure collection, please place loose leaves roadside by 7:00am on the day your zone is scheduled for pick up (see zones below). *Brochure/map available at Village Hall.

Leaf Zones:

- Zone #1 (Monday): Northwest quarter of Village including areas from 60th St.(County Highway K) South 66th Street and from 240th Ave west to 248th Court.
- Zone #2 (Wednesday): East side of Paddock Lake including areas south of 60th St (County Highway K) to 75th St (Hwy 50) and from 239th Ave east to 232nd Ave.
- Zone #3 (Thursday): All areas south of Highway 50.
- Zone #4 (Friday): West side of Village including areas from 67th St south to 75th St (Hwy 50) and from 251st Ave east to 242nd Ave (Includes 74th Pl).

Optional Yard Waste Drop off Locations:

- Public Works Facility at the east end of 62nd St.
- Hooker Lake, near boat-lift station.
- 250th Ave & 68th St Location.

Branch Chipping

The Public Works Crew continually processes yard trimmings (brush). Woodchips are available for Village residents free of charge. Wood chips may be obtained at the yard waste drop off site at the Public Works facility located at the far east end of 62nd St.

Trimmed tree branches may be placed at the road side for pick up. Stack branches at the side of the road. Place the large cut ends towards the road in the same direction. Please make sure there are no metal objects in or on the branches.

Larger logs, branches, and smaller twigs should all be placed into separate piles and NOT piled onto each other.

Roots attached to branches: All dirt must be removed from the root ball. Root ball cannot measure more than 12" in diameter.
