



Chloride Reduction Rebate Program

Paddock Lake is required to investigate chloride sources and make reductions in the amount of chloride discharged into the Village sanitary sewer system. Most of salt being discharged to the collection system and treatment plant is coming from water softeners used in homes. Paddock Lake is offering rebates to residential sewer users who significantly reduce or eliminate salt discharges to the sewer system. questions can be emailed to tpopanda@paddocklake.net or call Village Administrator at 262-843-3617.

The following rebates will be offered to Paddock Lake sewer users in 2026-2027 as an initial pilot program:

\$150.00 user rate reduction credit for Paddock Lake residential sewer customers who have their salt-based water softeners optimized (tuned-up) by a Wisconsin licensed plumber or a qualified and recognized water treatment system vendor.

\$200.00 user rate reduction credit for Paddock Lake residential sewer customers who replace an inefficient timer-based water softener with a new demand-initiated water treatment device.

Eligibility

To be considered for the two sewer rate reduction credits, Village sewer customers must meet the following standards:

- Sewer customers seeking rate reduction credits must be current on all fees owed to the Village, including property taxes, utility bills, fines, and special assessments.
- Be residential customers of the Village Municipal Sanitary Sewer Utility District.
- Home must currently have a working softener.
- Homeowners with timer-based softeners with salt efficiency less than 3350 grains/Lb. are eligible for a one-time \$200.00 user charge credit to replace the softener with an efficient (4000 gr/lb.) demand-initiated softener. Credits or rebates are not retroactive and must be replaced or optimized after July 1, 2025.
- Customers requesting incentives must submit to the Village a completed rebate form.
